



Flutter Christmas Tree runner

Ready to whip up a fun tree runner for the holidays and beyond? Brooke here from Silly Mama Quilts to share this project with you. The finished size of this runner is 16 x 41.



Supplies:

6 fat quarters

1.5 yards of white background

3 inch strip of brown for trunks – cut by 2.5 inches

½ yard for each the border and binding

1 yard for the backing

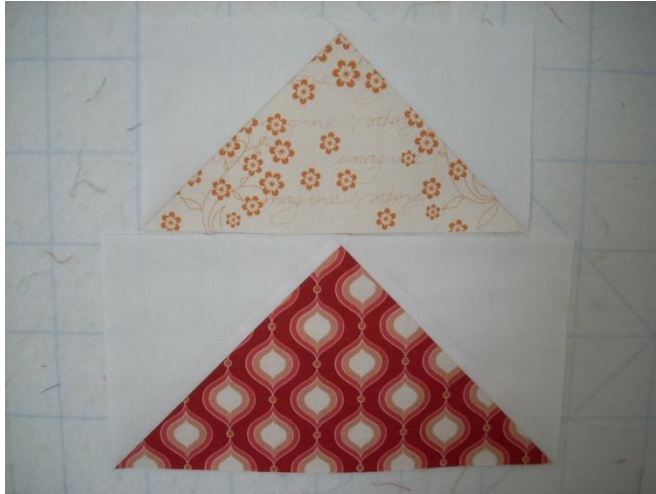


I first selected fabric sets for the three tree blocks.



Small trees are 4.5 inches cut by 8.5 rectangles

Large tree is 5.5 inches cut by 10.5



White background cut

5.5 inch strip, cut six 5.5 inch squares

4.5 inch strip, cut 6 squares and six 3 x 4.5 rectangles

3 inch strip, cut 5 inch rectangles

I did magic corners on the tree rectangles with the white background squares.



Sew each row together.

Trim the block to 10.5 x 12



Sew tree blocks together in a pleasing arrangement



Cut three 3.5 inch strips of border fabric and sew to the tree unit.



All ready to quilt my project.



I did a variety of quilting.
